The petitioner has invoked the writ jurisdiction of this Court in terms of Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking appropriate writ of mandamus for issuance of directions to the respondents to release the pensionary benefits in the form of pro-rata monthly pension, gratuity and other admissible retiral benefits to the petitioner with interest @ 18% p.a. along with arrears as he served the BSF for a period of more than ten years before joining the Union Bank of India in terms of rules (Annexure P1) and order (Annexure P2) as well as to decide the legal notice dated 29/30.12.2020 (Annexure P-10).

Heard.

Notice of motion to the official respondents.

Mr. Ankur Sharma, Senior Panel Counsel, Union of India puts in appearance and accepts notice on behalf of the said respondents. Copy of the paper book has been supplied to him.

Upon hearing learned counsel for both the sides and on perusal of the records, the present petition stands disposed off with direction to the official respondents to consider the legal notice dated 29/30.12.2020 (Annexure P10), as representation of the petitioner and decide the same in accordance with law by passing a speaking order preferably within a period of one month from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

If found entitled and if there is no impediment for the release of payment, the same be granted to the petitioner without any delay, as per law.

The petition stands disposed off accordingly.
