Petitioner being convict in case FIR No.796 dated 16.12.1999, under Section 302 IPC and Section 27 Arms Act, registered at Police Station City Sirsa, has approached this Court for parole in order to attend the marriage of his niece, which is scheduled to take place on 29.12.2021.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has argued that the petitioner is in custody for the last approximately eight years and the concession of parole extended to him previously was never misused. He states that during the Pandemic, he remained on parole for a period of one year and on every occasion, he surrendered in time.

On 21.12.2021, learned State counsel had sought time to seek instructions regarding the ground raised by the petitioner and in response, he has produced the communication dated 21.12.2021 from Superintendent of Prison, Central Prison-1, Hisar, wherein it is mentioned that indeed the marriage of the niece of the petitioner is scheduled to take place on

29.12.2021.

Considering the above, the petition is allowed and it is ordered that the petitioner be released on parole for a period of four weeks subject to his furnishing requisite bonds to the satisfaction of the authorities concerned. He shall surrender on 23.01.2022 by 4:00 P.M. before the jail authorities,
