The petitioners have approached this Court seeking protection of their life and liberty on the premise that petitioner No.1 has performed marriage with petitioner No.2 against the wishes of her parents and other family members and the petitioners are apprehending threat to their life and liberty at their instance.

Notice of motion.

On asking of the Court, Mr. Ramdeep Partap Singh, DAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State.

Learned counsel for the petitioners has submitted that this is second marriage of both the petitioners and their first marriages were

dissolved by way of decree of divorce (Annexures P-6 & P-7). It is further submitted that petitioner No.1 is having a minor girl namely Tejal aged about 07 years and is living in her custody and similarly, petitioner No.2 is also having a minor boy namely Mahakjeet Singh aged about 08 years, who is also living with petitioner No.2 and both the petitioners will take care of upbringing of both the children. It is also submitted that a representation dated 19.12.2021 was made to the Senior Superintendent of Police, SAS Nagar (Mohali) (Annexure P-5) seeking necessary protection but no action has been taken so far in the matter.

Heard.

Without examining the question of validity or otherwise of marriage of the petitioners, the present petition stands disposed of with a direction to the Senior Superintendent of Police, SAS Nagar (Mohali) to look into grievance of the petitioners expressed in the representation (Annexure P-5) and take appropriate action, if any, warranted in the circumstances.
