Petitioner Navneet Kumar @ Navneet Kwatra, working as a Clerk in Municipal Corporation, Ambala Cantt., got involved in a criminal case registered vide FIR No.0268 dated 28.06.2021, under Sections 406, 420, 467, 468 and 471 IPC. Resultantly, he was removed from service, however, as a result of investigation, his involvement was not found in the case. He approached respondent No.2-Commissioner, Municipal Corporation, Ambala seeking reinstatement in service and had submitted representation dated 01.12.2021 (Annexure P-18) but that did not evoke any response. As such, he has filed the present writ petition.

At the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioner states that he would be satisfied if a direction is issued to respondent No.2 to dispose of the representation and then take appropriate action in the matter.

Under the circumstances, in order to enable the respondents to consider the claim of the petitioner and to avoid unnecessary litigation, the present writ petition is disposed of directing respondent No.2-Commissioner, Municipal Corporation, Ambala to consider the representation dated 01.12.2021 (Annexure P-18) of the petitioner as per law, rules, regulations and instructions on the subject and if some action in the matter is warranted, then the needful be done in accordance with law, within a period of 01 month from the date of receipt of copy of this order, by way of passing a speaking order, copy of which be sent to the petitioner as per registered AD post.
