The petitioner has invoked the jurisdiction of this Court in terms of Article 226 of the Constitution of India seeking prayer by way of writ of *certiorari* for setting aside the order dated 06.12.2019 (Annexure P-9) passed by respondent No.3 and directing respondents to grant the arrears to the petitioner from 05.02.2009, the date 36 months prior to filing of the Civil Writ Petition No.3119 of 2012 to 30.11.2011, as granted to other similarly situated employees and/or grant any other relief as this Hon'ble Court may deem fit in the circumstances of the case.
