The petitioners have come up in this civil writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking a prayer by way of writ of *mandamus* directing the respondents to promote petitioner as principals notionally from the date their junior in master cadre respondent No.3 had been promoted as Principal alongwith all consequential benefits i.e. fixation of pay/pension, ACP, arrears etc., alongwith interest @ 12% per annum, for which, legal notice dated 20.11.2020 (Annexure P-5) has also been served upon the respondent authorities.

Heard.

Upon hearing learned counsel for the petitioners, the

directions are issued to the respondent-authorities to duly consider the legal notice dated 20.11.2020 (Annexure P-5) as representation of the petitioners and decide the same in accordance with law by passing a speaking order, preferably, within a period of one month from the date of receipt of copy of this order.

If the petitioners are held entitled for so claimed relief and there is no impediment for granting the same, the relief be released to them without any delay.
