The case has been taken up for hearing through video-conferencing.

Petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C in case bearing FIR No.58 dated 15.04.2019 registered under Sections 420, 406 IPC, Police Station Dhanaula, District Barnala.

Notice of motion was issued on 04.10.2019 and the interim anticipatory bail was also granted to the petitioner. The complainant was ordered to be impleaded as party respondent No.2 vide order dated 14.01.2020. As per office report, notice issued to respondent No.2 has been received back duly served, but none has appeared on behalf of respondent No.2.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Sher Singh submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation on 05.11.2019 and his presence is no more required for further investigation in the case.

In view of the statement made by learned State counsel, the interim order dated 04.10.2019 is made absolute. Petitioner shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so and he shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands disposed of.
