The petitioners claim themselves to be major. They have pleaded that they have married against the wishes of respondents No.4 to 6 and seek protection to their life and liberty. They apprehend danger from respondents No.4 to 6. They have placed on record photographs (Annexure P-5) and marriage certificate (Annexure P-4) evidencing their marriage.

Petitioners have also submitted a representation dated 18.12.2021 (Annexure P-6) to respondent No.2, but no action has been taken so far.

Notice of motion to the official respondents only.

At this stage, Ms. Rashmi Attri, AAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the official respondents. Let adequate copies of the paper book be supplied to her during the course of day.

Without entering upon an exercise to evaluate the evidentiary value of the documents placed on the file, I dispose of this petition with directions to respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Hoshiarpur to decide the

representation of the petitioners (Annexure P-6) within a period of one week from the date of receipt of a copy of this order and grant them protection, if any threat to their life and liberty is perceived. It is made clear that this order shall not be taken to protect the petitioners from legal action for violation of law, if any, committed by them.
