The petitioner has invoked the jurisdiction of this Court in terms of Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking prayer by way of writ of *mandamus* for issuance of directions to the respondents to grant of family pension, gratuity, leave encashment and other pensionary benefits to the petitioner being widow of (deceased-employee Sh. Dalwinder Singh) and appointment on the compassionate ground in place of her husband as husband of petitioner had died before regularization and thereby treating it as notional regularization in view of the law laid down in judgment passed in CWP No. 3320 of 2013 dated 10.02.2015

(Annexure P-4) and LPA No.1483 of 2015 dated 16.05.2017 (Annexure P-5) by the Hon'ble Division Bench of this Hon'ble Court.

Notice of motion to the official respondents.

Ms. Simran Grewal, DAG, Punjab puts in appearance and accepts notice on behalf of the official respondents-State. Copy supplied.

Heard.

Upon hearing learned counsel of both sides and on perusal of the records, the present petition stands disposed off with the directions to the official respondents to consider the legal notice dated 12.01.2019 (Annexure P-6) as representation moved by the petitioner and decide the same in accordance with law, by passing a speaking order preferably within a period of one month from the date of receipt of the certified copy of this order.

If found entitled and if there is no impediment for the relief, the same be granted to the petitioner without any delay, as per law.

The petition stands disposed off accordingly.
