The petitioner has invoked the jurisdiction of this Court in terms of Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking prayer by way of writ of *mandamus* for issuance of directions to the respondents to release the pension of the petitioner of the months of July, 2021 and August, 2021 that too after calculating the last pay drawn correctly, the correct Pension of the months of September, 2021 to November, 2021 and thereafter, calculating the last pay drawn correctly, to release the correctly calculated

communication of pension and the group insurance scheme amount, the remaining amount of the leave encashment, the gratuity and the General Provident Fund amount as per the correct last pay drawn and also pay interest @18% per annum on all the delayed payments of the retiral and pensionary dues from the date same fell due till the date of actual realization for the issuance of an appropriate writ, order or direction especially in the nature of *mandamus* directing the respondents to release the benefit of 3rd Modified Assured Career Progression Scheme due since 11.06.2016 upon completion of 30 years service as Junior Hindi Stenographer and grant all consequential benefits.

Heard.

Upon hearing learned counsel for the petitioner and on perusal of the records, the present petition stands disposed off with the directions to the official respondents to consider the representations dated 18.01.2017; 08.10.2018; 18.12.2019; 24.07.2020 and 13.12.2021 (Annexures P-11 to P-15) moved by the petitioner and decide the same in accordance with law, by passing a speaking order preferably within a period of one month from the date of receipt of the certified copy of this order.

If found entitled and if there is no impediment for the

relief, the same be granted to the petitioner without any delay, as per law.

The petition stands disposed off accordingly.
