The instant criminal writ petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the official respondents to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners and their associate members at the hands of private respondents No.4 to 7.

Learned counsel for the petitioners, at the very outset, would submit that for their grievance, the petitioners have already submitted a representation dated 14.12.2021 (Annexure P-5) to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Fatehgarh Sahib i.e. respondent No.2 herein, but no action has been taken thereon so far. The petitioners would be satisfied in case the said representation be decided in a time bound manner.

Notice of motion to the official respondents only at this stage.

On the asking of the Court, Ms. Rashmi Attri, AAG, Punjab, who is present in the Court, accepts notice on behalf of official respondents and would submit that the official respondents will look into the matter and will take a decision on the representation of the petitioner.

Let sufficient number of copies of the complete paper book be supplied to her during the course of day.

In view of the above, the present petition is disposed of by directing respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Fatehgarh Sahib, to take a decision on the representation 14.12.2021 (Annexure P-5) of the petitioners, within a period of six weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order, in accordance with law.
