The petitioner has invoked the jurisdiction of this Court in terms of Article 226 of the Constitution of India seeking prayer by way of writ of *mandamus* for issuance of directions to the respondents to count the service of the petitioner rendered from 03.11.1980 to 31.01.1983 for all service and pensionary benefits and to revise the pay of the petitioner after adding all notional benefits.

Heard.

Upon hearing learned counsel for the petitioner and on

perusal of the records, the present petition stands disposed off with the directions to the respondents to consider the legal notice dated 04.08.2021 (Annexure P-5) as representation moved by the petitioner and decide the same in accordance with law, by passing a speaking order preferably within a period of one month from the date of receipt of the certified copy of this order.

If found entitled and if there is no impediment for the relief, the same be granted to the petitioner without any delay, as per law.

The petition stands disposed off accordingly.
