After arguing for some time, learned Counsel for petitioner, on instructions, states that instead of pressing the present petition on merits, his client would be satisfied in case representation dated 09.12.2021 (P-5) is decided expeditiously.

On the asking of the Court, Ms. Maloo Chahal, DAG, Punjab, present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and raises no objection against the innocuous prayer of the petitioner.

In view of the agreed stand taken by both sides, but without going into the merits of the controversy, this writ petition is disposed off with direction to respondent No.2-Director, Department of Health & Family Welfare, Punjab to consider and decide the aforesaid representation in accordance with law by passing
