TEJINDER SINGH DHINDSA J.(Oral)

Petitioner being the highest bidder, was allotted a plot in the New Grain Market, Taraori, District Karnal on 31.12.2013. Vide order dated 06.03.2021 a resumption order was passed qua the plot in question on account of non-payment of the installments. Petitioner filed an appeal and the same stands dismissed vide order dated 26.11.2021 (Annexure P-4) passed by the Appellate Authority.

Apparently, petitioner thereafter filed a revision petition before the State Government on 01.12.2021.

It is the grievance raised by the counsel that the revision petition is not being listed for hearing and on the other hand coercive steps are being initiated against the petitioner to vacate the plot.

During the pre-lunch session we had requested to Mr. Aman Bahri, Addl. A.G. Haryana, to complete instructions in the matter.

During the post lunch session, learned State counsel informs us that date of hearing in the revision petition would be fixed within next 10 working days and the same would be conveyed to the petitioner. The revision petition would be decided on merits thereafter within a period of 40 days.

In the light of such categoric stand taken, there would be no occasion for this Court to examine the validity of the order of resumption as also the order passed by the Appellate Authority affirming the action of resumption.

Writ petition is disposed of.

Suffice it to observe that in case the petitioner moves any application before the revisional authority seeking interim directions, the same would be taken up on priority hearing and an order would be passed thereupon as well.
