Instant petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C seeking direction to respondents No.2 to 4 not to unnecessarily harass the petitioners and not to stop them from entering into their own house at the instance of the private respondents No.5 and 6.

Counsel for the petitioners submits that petitioner No.1 is the wife and petitioner No.2 is the minor son of respondent No.5. He submits that the marriage had taken place 08 years ago, but there is matrimonial dispute between the parties and by virtue of oral compromise entered into between the parties, with the intervention of the respectables, the petitioners were permitted to live on the first floor of the residential house, however, later on, the petitioners were not permitted to enter into the premises. Counsel submits that all the household articles, clothes etc., of the petitioners are lying in the said premises and though the petitioners have

submitted a representation dated 09.12.2021 (Annexure P-4) to the Senior Superintendent of Police, District Patiala highlighting their pathetic situation, yet, the same has not yielded any result. He submits that the petitioners will be satisfied in case a direction is issued to the concerned official respondent to examine the representation.

Request of counsel for the petitioners has been considered.

Without advertng to the merits of the petitioners' allegations at this stage, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to Senior Superintendent of Police, Patiala-respondent No.2 to consider the representation dated 09.12.2021 (Annexure P-4) and thereafter, to take appropriate steps as warranted, in accordance with law.

A copy of this order alongwith copy of representation, Annexure P-4 be sent to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Patiala respondent No.2 to enable him to do the needful expeditiously.
