The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.134 dated 16.09.2019 under Sections 354, 323, 341, 506, 148 and 149 IPC registered at Police Station Urban Estate, Patiala, District Patiala.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the occurrence in question emanates from a trivial dispute between two groups of students and it was on account of the same that the petitioner was assigned a role in the FIR in question to the effect that he had indulged in eve-teasing. It has been submitted that even the injuries attributed to the petitioner are simple in nature. Vide order dated 13.11.2019 passed by the Coordinate Bench, the petitioner had been directed to join investigation in compliance of which he has joined investigation and cooperated with the investigating agency.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Kuldeep Singh, has conceded that in compliance of order dated 13.11.2019, the

petitioner has joined the investigation and submitted that his custodial interrogation is not required in the case.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed and interim order dated 13.11.2019, is made absolute subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
