ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J. (ORAL)

The petitioners are seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.254, dated 20.09.2018, under Sections 406, 420, 506 and 120-B IPC, registered at Police Station Sadar Dabwali, District Sirsa.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that petitioner No.2 is not named in the FIR while allegations against petitioner No.1 are that she had introduced the complainant to accused-Sharwan Singh, who is her husband. He also contends that the petitioners have been falsely implicated in this case as petitioner No.1 is the wife of accused-Sharwan Singh and petitioner No.2 is the father of accused-Sharwan Singh, who is 69 years old. He further contends that co-accused, namely, Sharwan Singh and Shalender have been granted regular bail and the mother of accused-Sharwan Singh, namely, Bimla Devi has also been granted anticipatory bail. He further states that there is no allegation that any money was paid to the petitioners and the petitioners are not involved in any other case.

This Court, by the order dated 05.11.2019, had directed the petitioners to appear before the Investigating Officer and join the investigation and in the event of their arrest, they were to be released on ad-interim bail to the satisfaction of the Investigating/Arresting Officer, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from ASI Vikash, states that although the petitioners have joined investigation but they are not cooperating. She also contends that it is alleged that the money in cash had also been paid to the petitioners.

In view of the above and the petitioners having joined investigation, the order dated 05.11.2019 granting interim bail to the petitioners is made absolute.

However, the petitioners shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. They shall also join investigation as and when called upon to do so.

The petition stands disposed of.
