Petitioner No.1 is stated to be 20 years old and petitioner No.2 is stated to be aged 19 years.

Petitioners as per counsel are living in live-in-relationship.

Instant petition has been filed seeking issuance of directions to the official respondents to take adequate measures for the protection of life and liberty by voicing an apprehension and threat to the same at the hands of private respondents No.4 and 5 and who in turn happen to be the parents of petitioner No.1.

Pleadings on record are wholly insufficient for this Court to infer any imminent danger to the life and liberty of the petitioners. Bald averments made in paragraph 6 of the petition which only voice an apprehension and nothing more.

In the light of pleadings on record, the prayer made in the instant petition cannot be accepted.

Petition is dismissed.
