The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C.,
for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in case FIR No.146 dated
19.09.2019 under Sections 420, 498-A, 406 and 120-B of the IPC registered
at Police Station Mattaur, District SAS Nagar (Mohali).

It is the case of the petitioners that the FIR in question was got registered on account of matrimonial dispute between the parties.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits vide Annexure P-6, a compromise has been arrived at between the parties. He further submits that in compliance of order dated 10th January, 2020, passed by the co-ordinate Bench of this Court, the petitioners have joined investigation.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Baljit Singh does not dispute the said fact and submits that the petitioners are not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed and interim order dated 10th January, 2020 is made absolute subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438(2) CrPC.
