LISA GILL, J.

Petitioners seek protection of their life and liberty as they apprehend danger at the hands of respondents No.4 to 6 and other relatives because they have solemnized marriage on 27.12.2021 against the wishes of said respondents.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that he has identified the petitioners as per the documents attached. It is further submitted that they have solemnized marriage with each other out of their own free will and volition and that this is their first marriage. It is contended that the petitioners are major, their dates of birth being 05.02.2002 and 11.11.1999, respectively. True copies of Aadhaar Cards of both the petitioners have been appended with the petition as Annexures P-1 and P-2, respectively. A copy of the Marriage Certificate is on record as Annexure P-3. It is submitted that there is no

impediment to the marriage of the petitioners. Petitioners, it is stated, have submitted representation dated 27.12.2021 (Annexure P-4) to respondent No.2 i.e., the Senior Superintendent of Police, SAS Nagar (Mohali), Punjab, for redressal of their grievance but no action has been taken thereon.

Notice of motion to respondents no.1 to 3.

Mr. Amit Mehta, Sr. DAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3. Advance copy of the petition stands served.

Without commenting upon the age of the petitioners or validity of their marriage or validity and genuineness of the certificates/documents appended with the petition, respondent No.2 – Senior Superintendent of Police, SAS Nagar (Mohali), Punjab is directed to look into representation dated 27.12.2021 submitted by the petitioners and take appropriate action if any/as may be required, keeping in view the threat perception to the petitioners.

Petition is disposed of accordingly.
