[1] Learned counsel contends that initially the petitioner had contacted him on telephone and thereafter met him in his office on 4-5 occasions and informed him of his grievance against his parents. Learned counsel further contends that today, he received an e-mail from his client informing him that his mother and father had come to the hotel where he was staying alongwith two police officers and were taking him home against his wishes. Learned counsel has frankly conceded that the petitioner is a minor as also that the petitioner remained under psychiatric treatment, though against his wishes and that CRWP-12332-2021 has been filed simply by attaching the e-mail and the narrative allegedly given by the petitioner at his office.

[2] Learned counsel after arguing for sometime prays for permission to withdraw the instant petition with liberty to file a fresh petition

with better particulars in a proper format.

[3] In view of the statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is dismissed as withdrawn with the liberty as prayed for.
