Mr. Manjot Gujral, Advocate has put in appearance on behalf of respondents No.4 to 6 and has filed his Vakalatnama, which is taken on record.

Neha and Madan Mohan Singh, the petitioners before this Court, claim themselves to be of marriageable age. They have pleaded that they have married against the wishes of respondents No.4 to 6. They apprehend danger from them and seek protection of their life and liberty. They have placed on record Marriage Certificate and Marriage Photographs, Annexures P-3 and P-4, respectively, evidencing their marriage. The petitioners have submitted a representation dated 28.12.2021, Annexure P-5, to Senior Superintendent of Police, Amritsar, respondent No.2.

Without entering upon an exercise to evaluate the evidentiary value of the documents placed on the file, the petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to decide the representation of the petitioners, Annexure P-5 and grant them protection, if any threat to their life and liberty is perceived. It is made clear that this order shall not be taken to protect the petitioners from legal action for violation of law, if any, committed by them.
