Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No.0576 dated 28.08.2018, registered under Sections 409, 420, 506 and 34 of the IPC at Police Station Meham, Rohtak.

The operative part of the order dated 17.10.2019, vide which the petitioner has been granted interim bail, is reproduced below:

“It is contended by counsel for the petitioner that allegations in the case are regarding awarding the sub-contract of survey of clean drinking water; on behalf of the Company Gajraj Info Private Limited. It is also alleged that the complainant paid about Rs.12 lakhs for said sub-contract, but no amounts are being paid for the work done by the complainant and all threats are being extended by the accused, for demanding the money back by the complainant, which he had paid for award of the said contract. However, the petitioner is neither the owner of the said Gajraj Info Pvt. Ltd., nor is he having any other interest in the said Company. As per the allegation, the petitioner is not alleged even to have taken any money

from the complainant; as such. Therefore, there is no question of the petitioner extending any threat to the complainant. The dispute is a civil dispute, between Gajraj Infor Pvt. Ltd. and the complainant.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner, in pursuance to the order dated 17.10.2019, has already appeared before the SHO/Investigating Officer and has joined the investigation.

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from the Investigating Officer, has not disputed the factual position and submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is no more required for any further investigation.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner, vide order dated 17.10.2019, is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
