Case taken up through video conferencing.

The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.50 dated 10.06.2019, under Sections 21 and 29 of the NDPS Act, registered at Police Station Special Task Force, District SAS Nagar.

On 17.10.2019, a Coordinate Bench of this Court had passed the following order:-

“Learned counsel for petitioner submits that recovery in this case was effected from Jagan alias Jagga and Navrang Singh. The allegations against the petitioner is that he was also third rider on the motor cycle being driven by Jagan alias Jagga and had ran away from the spot. The question is of identity of the person who had ran away from the spot and the petitioner is ready to join the investigation.

Notice of motion for 27.1.2020.

Petitioner is directed to surrender before the police and join investigation within two weeks. In the event of his arrest being required, he shall be released on interim bail till the next date, subject to his furnishing bonds to the satisfaction of Arresting Officer. However, he shall abide by the terms and conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2)(i) to (iv) Cr.P.C. failing which he shall lose the benefit of interim bail allowed to him.”

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from ASI Naresh Kumar, states that the petitioner has joined investigation.

In view of the above and the petitioner having joined investigation, the order dated 17.10.2019 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. He shall also join investigation as and when called upon to do so.

The petition stands disposed of.
