CM-963-CWP-2021

CM-964-CWP-2021

Present application has been filed for withdrawal of the main writ petition.

In view of above and for the reasons mentioned in the application, the same is allowed as prayed for subject to all just exceptions.

MAIN CASE

Present writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for quashing the impugned order dated 03.02.2016 (P-4), vide which, case of the petitioner for grant of step-up of pay at par with his junior has been rejected. Further prayer is for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to grant the benefit of stepping up of pay to the petitioner at par with his junior from the date of anomaly along with all consequential benefits with interest.

In view of the above order, passed in CM-964-CWP-2021, this writ petition is dismissed as withdrawn as grievance of the petitioner has been redressed.

Since main writ petition stands withdrawn, therefore, the pending applications, if any, shall also dispose off.
