The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C.,
for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.154 dated
02.09.2019 under Sections 406, 498-A, 323 and 34 of the IPC registered at
Police Station Bhogpur, District Jalandhar Rural.

Learned counsel submits that in compliance of order dated 18th
October 2019 passed by a coordinate Bench of this Court in the following
terms, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

*“Learned counsel for the petitioner inter alia contends
that the petitioner who happens to be the mother-in-law of the
complainant, has not been specifically entrusted any article of
Istridhan and that nothing is to be recovered. Notice of motion
for 28.02.2020. Meanwhile, in the event of arrest, the petitioner
be released on interim bail to the satisfaction of
arresting/Investigating Officer. The petitioner shall, however,*

join the investigation as and when called for to do so and she shall also abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.”

Learned State counsel on instructions from SI Premjit Singh submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is no longer required for further interrogation. He has further apprised the Court that challan stands presented in the Court.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed and interim order dated 18th October 2019 is made absolute subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438(2) CrPC.
