1. The petitioners have approached this Court seeking quashing of FIR No.62 dated 17.06.2015 registered against them at Police Station Gidderbaha, District Sri Muktsar Sahib, under Sections 498-A/506/354/34 IPC (Section 406 IPC added later on) and all subsequent proceedings emanating therefrom on the basis of a compromise having been effected between the parties.
2. Vide order dated 24.11.2020, the parties had been directed to appear before the Illaqa Magistrate/trial Court so as to get their statements recorded qua the factum of compromise.
3. Report of learned Sub Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Gidderbaha has been received, wherein it has been reported that the statements of accused/petitioners Jugraj Dhamija, Bimla Rani, Rituraj @ Ricky and Sonia and also of complainant Dimple have been

recorded to the effect that they have compromised the matter amongst themselves.

4. The complainant Dimple in her statement has stated that she has no objection in case the FIR in question is quashed.
5. The learned Sub Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Gidderbaha has specifically opined that the parties have entered into compromise voluntarily without there being any pressure, coercion and undue influence.
6. In view of the aforesaid compromise and bearing in mind the law laid down by Full Bench of this Court in 2007(3) RCR (Crl.) 1052 Kulwinder Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab, the present petition is allowed and FIR No.62 dated 17.06.2015 registered at Police Station Gidderbaha, District Sri Muktsar Sahib, under Sections 498-A/506/354/34 IPC (Section 406 IPC added later on) and all subsequent proceedings emanating therefrom are hereby quashed qua petitioners.
