As per joint statement of learned counsel for the appellants, learned counsel and representative of the respondent – Insurance Company (separately recorded), a sum of Rs.1,50,000/- (Rs. One Lakh Fifty Thousand only) over and above the amount awarded by the Tribunal is allowed to the appellants in full and final settlement of the claim in this appeal. As per the joint statement, the enhanced amount shall be paid to the appellants in the ratio as apportioned by the MACT.

Accordingly, we settle this case with a direction to the Insurance Company to give a cheque for Rs.1,50,000/- in the name of the appellants in the office of the Lok Adalat of the High Court within one month, failing which, interest @ 9% per annum shall be payable from the date of this order till actual payment. The appellants' counsel/appellants may collect the cheque from the office of the Lok Adalat.

Copy of the order be supplied/sent to learned counsels/parties
and file be returned to the Hon'ble High Court.
