The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.223 dated 25.09.2019, under Sections 420, 465, 467, 468, 471, 120-B of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station Beas District Amritsar.

A Coordinate Bench of this Court, on 24.10.2019, had passed the following order:-

“Contents that the present FIR is the result of complaints dated 19.03.2019 (P-4) and 10.06.2019 (P-6) and moreover, in CRM M-44136 of 2019 filed by co-accused, namely, Kaushalya, this Court has already granted interim protection.

Notice of motion for 02.12.2019.

To be heard along with CRM M-44136 of 2019.

In the meanwhile, the petitioner is directed to join the investigation before the Investigating Officer. In the event of his arrest, the Arresting Officer would admit him to interim bail till the next date of hearing on his furnishing adequate bail and surety bonds to his satisfaction. The petitioner is also directed to abide by all the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.”

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from ASI Balkar Singh, states that the petitioner has joined investigation.

In view of the above and the petitioner having joined investigation, the Covid-19 Pandemic, the order dated 24.10.2019 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. He shall also join investigation as and when called upon to do so.

The petition stands disposed of.
