This petition has been filed by the petitioners under Section 438 Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.92 dated 15.06.2019, under Section 420 Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station Baghapurana, District Moga. The petitioners apprehended their arrest at the hands of Police, in the above FIR.

Learned counsel for the petitioners has invited the attention of the Court to the order dated 23.10.2019, whereby, while issuing notice of motion to respondent-State, the interim protection was extended to the petitioners. The said order reads as under:-

“Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that petitioners are mother-in-law and uncle, respectively of the complainant and dispute between the parties has been settled and has invited the

attention of the Court to the compromise dated 31.07.2019 (Annexure P-3).

Notice of motion for 04.03.2020.

At this stage, Mr. K.S.Khaira, Advocate appears on behalf of complainant and files power of attorney which is taken on record.

Meanwhile, the petitioners shall join the investigation and would come present as and when called for and in the event of arrest, the petitioners shall be admitted to interim bail on their furnishing personal and surety bonds to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer. The petitioners shall also abide by the conditions as specified under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.”

Learned counsel for the petitioners further contends that in deference to the said order, the petitioners submitted themselves before the Police and joined the investigation. According to him, the petitioners cooperated with the Police Authorities during the investigation and furnished requisite bonds to the satisfaction of the Investigating Officer/Arresting Officer.

Learned State counsel, who is assisted by ASI Sardara Singh does not dispute this fact that the petitioners have joined the investigation and they are not required for custodial interrogation for the time being. He further states that final report also stands filed.

Considering the above, the petition is allowed and the interim bail granted by this Court vide order dated 23.10.2019 is made absolute.
