The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No. 208 dated 16.08.2019, under Sections 458, 324, 323, 506, 148 and 149 IPC, registered at Police Station Kotwali Patiala, District Patiala.

A coordinate Bench of this court, on 30.10.2019, had passed the following order:-

“Heard.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has not been named in the FIR and has been arrayed as accused on the statement of complainant that some unknown persons were also accompanying the main assailants.

Notice of motion for 11.02.2020.

Petitioner is directed to surrender before the police and join investigation within two weeks. In the event of his arrest being required, he shall be released on interim bail till the next date, subject to his furnishing bonds to the satisfaction of

Arresting Officer. However, he shall abide by the terms and conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2)(i) to (iv) Cr.P.C. failing which he shall lose the benefit of interim bail allowed to him.”

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from SI Kuldeep Singh, states that the petitioner has joined investigation.

In view of the above and the petitioner having joined investigation, the order dated 30.10.2019 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. He shall also join investigation as and when called upon to do so.

The petition stands disposed of.
