Learned counsel for the parties submits that the parties have compromised their dispute vide Compromise dated 15.03.2021 and keeping in view the compromise, the appellant has undertaken not to press this RSA.

Once the parties have already compromised their dispute and are satisfied with the said compromise and the learned counsel(s) appearing on behalf of the respective parties submits that the said compromise has been effected without any coercion or undue pressure upon any of the parties and the parties are willing to execute their part of the agreement, the appellant's prayer for withdrawing the RSA in view of the compromise needs to be accepted.

Keeping in view the request of both the parties, the main appeal is taken up for hearing today.

Keeping in view the fact that the parties have already compromised their dispute willingly without any coercion or undue pressure and they are willing to execute their part as per the compromise dated 15.03.2021, the prayer of the appellant for withdrawing the present appeal in view of the compromise is accepted. Compromise is taken on record as mark 'A'.

The present appeal is disposed of having been withdrawn in view of the compromise dated 15.03.221 entered into between the parties.

As the main appeal has been withdrawn, CM No. 882-C of 2021 has been infructuous.
