The present petition has been filed under Section 438 of the Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.262, dated 13.09.2019, under Sections 323, 325, 498-A, 406 and 34 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station City Kapurthala, District Kapurthala.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of order dated 29.10.2019, the petitioner has joined investigation.

However, Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Harprashad, has apprised the Court that recovery of one pair of gold earrings is yet to be effected from the petitioner, who happens to be the mother-in-law of the complainant.

Learned State counsel has also apprised the Court on

instructions that during interregnum period the matter has been amicably settled between the parties and a petition-CRM-M-8359-2021 under Section 482 of the Cr.P.C. has been filed wherein the parties were directed to get their respective statements recorded before the trial Court with respect to the compromise arrived at between the parties.

Heard learned counsel for the parties as well as the perused the material on record.

In view of the facts and circumstances as referred above, the petition is allowed and interim order dated 29.10.2019, is made absolute subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438(2) Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973.
