At the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that he has prepared a draft of Rs.25,000/- in favour of the complainant, as directed vide order dated 18.03.2021 and shall handover the same to the counsel for the complainant today itself.

Learned counsel for the petitioner to do the needful today itself.

On the other hand, Mr. Rituraj Singh, Advocate, has put in appearance on behalf of the complainant and has submitted that he has sent his vakalatnama on WhatsApp group. Learned counsel for the complainant has submitted that the matter has since been amicably resolved amongst the parties. He has further submitted that he has no objection for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

Keeping in view the fact that the matter is stated to have been amicably resolved amongst the parties, the petition is accepted and

the petitioner, in the event of arrest, is ordered to be released on bail subject to his furnishing personal bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer. However, the petitioner shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and cooperate with the Arresting/Investigating Officer and shall abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
