1. The case has been taken up for hearing through video-conferencing.
2. Petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C in case bearing FIR No.425 dated 22.05.2019 registered under Sections 379 and 188 of IPC at Police Station Nuh, District Nuh.
3. Notice of motion was issued on 06.12.2019 on the premise that the FIR is the result of concoction on the basis of some unfounded suspicion. No person had seen the petitioner actually doing any mining work. The petitioner was ready to join investigation with full co-operation.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the order dated 06.12.2019, petitioner has joined the investigation to the entire satisfaction of the Investigating Officer.

5. Learned State counsel on instructions from HC Jamshed Khan admits the aforesaid fact and submits that the petitioner is no more required for further investigation in the case.

6. In view of aforesaid factual position, the interim order dated 06.12.2019 is made absolute. Petitioner shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so and he shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

7. Petition stands disposed of.
