Matter has been taken up through video conferencing via Webex facility in the light of the Pandemic Covid-19 situation and as per instructions.

Prayer in the present petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.61 dated 02.10.2019, under Sections 498-A, 406 of Indian Penal Code, at Police Station Women, District Bathinda.

Vide order dated 30.10.2019, the petitioner was directed to join investigation.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that pursuant to order dated 30.10.2019, petitioner has joined the investigation and the same is affirmed by learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Bhola Singh, that petitioner has joined the investigation and he is no more required for further custodial interrogation.
