The case has been taken up for hearing through video conferencing.

Petitioners seek grant of anticipatory bail in case bearing FIR No.318 dated 04.10.2019 registered under Sections 379-B, 341, 34 IPC at Police Station Talwandi Sabo, District Bathinda.

On 31.10.2019, following order was passed by the Co-ordinate Bench of this Court:-

*"It is contended by learned counsel for the petitioner that undisputedly there is no injury to the complainant. The case against the petitioners and their entire family has been concocted by the complainant, who happens to be the real sisters of the petitioners; for the reasons that the complainant had run away with a boy Sukhdeep Singh and on that account,*

*the family of the petitioners had lodged an FIR against the said Sukhdeep Singh. Hence, the present FIR has been concocted only as a pressure tactics.*

*Notice of motion for 20.03.2020.*

*Meanwhile, in the event of arrest, the petitioners be released on interim bail subject to their furnishing personal bonds/surety to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer. However, the petitioners shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and shall abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.*

Learned counsel for the petitioners submitted that the petitioners have joined the investigation on 14.11.2019 to the entire satisfaction of the Investigating Officer.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Rajinder Singh admitted the aforesaid fact and submitted that even thereafter cancellation report has been prepared and the same has been approved by the office of Sr. Superintendent of Police also. The cancellation report in all probability is going to be filed in the Court of Illaqa Magistrate very soon.

In view of aforesaid factual position, the interim order dated 31.10.2019 is made absolute. Petitioners shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so and they shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands disposed of.
