This petition has been filed by the petitioner under Section 438 Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.126 dated 25.08.2019, under Section 380, 120-B Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station Cantonment, Amritsar City, District Amritsar. The petitioner apprehended his arrest at the hands of Police, in the above FIR.

There is no representation on behalf of the petitioner.

This Court while issuing notice of motion to the respondent-State on 31.10.2019 had extended the interim protection to the petitioner. The said order reads as under:-

“Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the alleged incident of theft took place in the year 2014 and the complaint has been made by complainant, namely, Mukesh against Pallavi, who is her sister-inlaw. It is pointed out that the petitioner is brother of Pallavi and for that reason he has been falsely implicated. Mr. Sharma has pointed out that the main accused has already been granted the concession of anticipatory bail.

Notice of motion for 18.3.2020.

Meanwhile, the petitioner shall join the investigation and would come present as and when called for and in the event of arrest, the petitioner shall be admitted to interim bail on his furnishing personal and surety bonds to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer. The petitioner shall also abide by the conditions as specified under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. ”

Learned State counsel who is assisted by ASI Sukhwant Kumar states that the petitioner has joined the investigation and he is not required for custodial interrogation for the time being.

Considering the above, the petition is allowed and the interim bail granted by this Court vide order dated 31.10.2019 is made absolute.
