The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C., for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner, in case FIR No. 498, dated 11.09.2019, under Sections 313, 323, 498-A, 406, 342, 506, 34 of IPC, registered at Police Station Pehowa City, District Kurukshetra.

Learned counsel for the petitioner, at the outset, submits that the matter stands amicably settled between the parties. She further submits that petition bearing CRM-M No. 28236 of 2021 seeking quashing of the FIR, in question, already stands filed in which notice of motion has been issued for 08.09.2021. Learned counsel also submits that a petition under Section 13-B of Hindu Marriage Act has been filed by the parties wherein they have got their first motion statements recorded.

Learned State counsel also, on instructions, from ASI Krishan Lal, states that the petitioner is no longer required for further interrogation.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed and interim order

dated 2nd November, 2019, is made absolute subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
