Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.31 dated 21.04.2019 registered under Sections 307, 324, 323, 506, 148 and 149 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 at Police Station Mattewal, District Amritsar.

As per allegations in the FIR, registered at the instance of complainant Buta Singh, it is stated that complainant and his companion Tarsem Singh and others suffered injuries and in this regard, a cross case was also registered.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner, in pursuance to the order dated 26.11.2019, has already joined the investigation and there is no allegation of misuse of concession of bail

against the petitioner.

Reply, filed by way of affidavit of DSP, Sub Division Majitha, Amritsar, is on record.

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from SI Kewal Singh, has not disputed the factual position and submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is no more required for any further investigation.

In view of the above and considering the fact that petitioner is on interim bail for the last more than one and a half year and he has not misused the same, the present petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner, vide order dated 26.11.2019, is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
