Matter has been taken up through video conferencing via Webex facility in the light of the Pandemic Covid-19 situation and as per instructions.

Petitioners have preferred the instant petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C., for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.83 dated 14.09.2019, under Sections 494, 406, 506 of IPC and under Section 18 of Hindu Marriage Act 1985 and Section 9 of Child Marriage Prohibition Act, 2006, registered at Police Station SGN Dev Thermal Plant, District Bathinda.

By virtue of the order dated 02.08.2021, while granting interim protection, the petitioners were directed to join investigation. It has been contended by learned counsel for the petitioners that the petitioners have joined the investigation and fully cooperated and thus, the interim order may kindly be made absolute.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Iqbal Singh

has endorsed the same and submitted that petitioners are no more required for further investigation.

In view of the same, the interim order dated 02.08.2021, is made absolute subject to compliance of conditions as envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C. and the petition stands allowed.
