The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for quashing of FIR No.41 dated 06.04.2018 registered under Sections 186, 353 and 506 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 at Police Station Amargarh, District Sangrur (Annexure P-1) and all consequential proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise dated 02.11.2019 (Annexure P-2) effected between the parties.

Pursuant to order dated 27.07.2021 passed by the Coordinate Bench of this Court, the parties appeared before the Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Malerkotla to get their statements recorded. Learned Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Malerkotla, submitted his report vide letter No.493 dated 12.08.2021.

According to the report, learned Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Malerkotla, is satisfied that compromise effected between the parties is genuine, outcome of free consent of the parties and is without coercion from any quarter.

Considering the report of Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Malerkotla, dated 12.08.2021 and the fact that the compromise will bring peace and harmony between the parties, aforesaid FIR No.41 dated 06.04.2018 (Annexure P-1) and all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom, are quashed, qua the petitioner only.
