Case is taken up for hearing through video conferencing.

This is a petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case bearing FIR No.47 dated 29.05.2019 registered under Sections 379 and 34 IPC at Police Station GRP Hisar.

Vide order dated 13.11.2019 passed by a Coordinate Bench of this Court, the petitioner was granted *ad-interim* anticipatory bail and directed to join the investigation, with the conditions that if the assertion, qua involvement of the petitioner in other criminal cases, was found to be incorrect, then the present petition shall be dismissed on this score alone, and in that situation, grant of interim protection to the petitioner, would not be taken as creating any equities in his favour.

On 13.11.2019, learned counsel for the petitioner pointed

out that the assertion of the prosecution about the involvement of the petitioner in 21 cases is totally incorrect. However, it was further pointed out that the petitioner had falsely been involved in four cases and he had already been acquitted in those cases.

Learned State counsel, on the instructions from SI Jaibir Singh, submits that there are as many as 21 FIRs pending against the petitioner. He has placed on record the list of 21 cases pending against the petitioner, which is taken on record as 'Mark-A'.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties.

Perusal of the list of cases (Mark 'A') indicates that the petitioner is involved in 21 other FIRs containing similar allegations.

The assertions of learned counsel for the petitioner made on 13.11.2019 are, thus, incorrect.

Accordingly, the present petition for grant of anticipatory bail is dismissed.
