The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C., for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.237 dated 20.10.2019 under Section 306 IPC 1860 registered at Police Station Beas District Amritsar.

The case of petitioner is that his marriage was solemnized with Manjit Kaur (since deceased) about 18 years prior to the occurrence in question and on account of litigations between the parties, she had ended her life. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that even on a perusal of the suicide note left behind by the deceased, the essential ingredients to attract the mischief of Section 306 IPC was clearly amiss. He further submits that pursuant to order dated 10.01.2020, passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

This fact is not disputed by the counsel for the State. He on instructions from ASI Sukhwinder Singh states that the petitioner is no

longer required for further interrogation.

Learned counsel for the complainant has however, opposed the prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioner for extending the concession of bail as in her suicide note left behind by the deceased, she had stated that she was fed up of frequenting the Courts to pursue the litigations, which were pending between her and the petitioner.

Heard.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed and interim order dated 10.01.2020, is made absolute subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
