The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in a case FIR No.121, dated 15.10.2019, lodged under Sections 312, 313, 406, 498-A, of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 registered at Police Station Tapa Mandi, District Barnala, Punjab.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that pursuant to order dated 04.02.2020, passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation. This fact is not disputed by the counsel for the State as well.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Jasbir Singh, states that the petitioner is no longer required for further interrogation.

Learned counsel for the complainant submits that certain dowry articles have not yet been returned to the complainant. Learned counsel for the petitioner has, however, disputed the said fact and submitted that whatever

articles were in the possession of the petitioner stand returned and there is a recovery memo also in support of the same.

Learned State counsel does not dispute the submissions made by the learned counsel for the petitioner in the said regard.

In view of the aforesaid, the petition is allowed and interim order dated 04.02.2020 is made absolute subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438(2) Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973.
