Matter has been taken up through video conferencing via Webex facility in the light of the Pandemic Covid-19 situation and as per instructions.

The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No.221 dated 06.10.2019 registered under Sections 406, 498-A, 120-B IPC at Police Station City South Moga.

By virtue of order dated 17.08.2021, while granting interim protection, the petitioner was directed to join investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Harjinder Singh, has submitted that though the petitioner has joined the investigation, however, some dowry articles are yet to be recovered. It is further submitted that supplementary challan has already been filed.
