The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C., for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.262 dated 13.09.2019 under Sections 323, 325, 498-A, 406 and 34 IPC 1860 registered at Police Station City Kapurthala District Kapurthala.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the parties have arrived at an amicable settlement and pursuant thereto petition under Section 13-B of the Hindu Marriage Act has been filed by them. He further submits that the petition under Section 482 Cr.PC for quashing of FIR on the basis of compromise has also been filed in which notice has been issued.

Learned State counsel does not dispute the submissions made by learned counsel for the petitioner. He on instructions from ASI Harparshad Taak submits that pursuant to order dated 10.01.2020, passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation and is no longer required for further interrogation.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed and interim order

dated 10.01.2020, is made absolute subject to the conditions laid down in  
Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
