Through this application, the petitioner prays for disposal of the writ petition in terms of the deed of compromise dated 21.01.2021, a photocopy whereof has been placed on record.

This writ petition has been filed challenging the correctness of orders passed by the Maintenance Tribunal constituted under the Maintenance and Welfare of Parents and Senior Citizens Act, 2007. Hence, it is considered appropriate to grant liberty to the parties to move an application before the Maintenance Tribunal.

The writ petition is disposed of in terms of the settlement.

However, the parties are directed to appear before the Maintenance Tribunal and produce original deed of settlement. The Maintenance Tribunal would also record the statements of the parties and, thereafter, disposed of the matter.

Since this application has been filed by the writ petitioner, therefore, respondent No.3 shall be at liberty to move an application for recall, if the facts are otherwise.
