Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.03 dated 02.01.2018 under Section 379-B IPC, registered at Police Station Sadar Tarn Taran, District Tarn Taran.

While granting interim bail to the petitioner, following order was passed by this Court on 18.11.2019: -

“...It is contended by learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner has been wrongly involved in this case. Otherwise, there is no material with the police to involve the petitioner in the case. The reliance of the prosecution is on the alleged disclosure statement of the co-accused. Still further, it is submitted that the

alleged motor cycle, used in the crime, also does not belong to the petitioner. In fact, the petitioner does not own any motor cycle as such....”

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the aforesaid order, the petitioner has joined the investigation and is no more required for further investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Surjeet Singh, has not disputed the factual position and submits that the petitioner is no more required for further investigation.

In view of the above, this petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 18.11.2019 is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
