AVNEESH JHINGAN, J (Oral):

Due to COVID-19 situation, the Court is convened through video conference.

This petition is filed for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No. 152 dated 1.10.2019, under Sections 306 and 120-B IPC, registered at Police Station Gidderbaha, District Sri Muktsar Sahib.

This Court vide order dated 22.11.2019 stayed the arrest of the petitioners.

Learned State Counsel, on instructions from ASI-Kulwant Singh submits that the petitioners have joined the investigation.

As no custodial interrogation is needed, the petitioners are granted anticipatory bail subject to their again joining investigation within two weeks. In the event of their arrest, the petitioners shall be released on bail subject to their furnishing adequate bail bonds to the satisfaction of the

Arresting Officer. They are directed to join the investigation as and when called for. They shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

The petition is allowed.
